Last May's lecturer Nirvana Romell (*Art Detectives: How to Look at and Decipher Paintings*) will apply her 'who-what-why-when-how-where' technique as she leads this guided visit to the National Gallery on the theme of 16th-17th century transitions in Italian art. It will take in important artists of the Italian Renaissance 1400-1600, Mannerism from 1520-1600 and the Baroque from the late 16th to early 18th century. 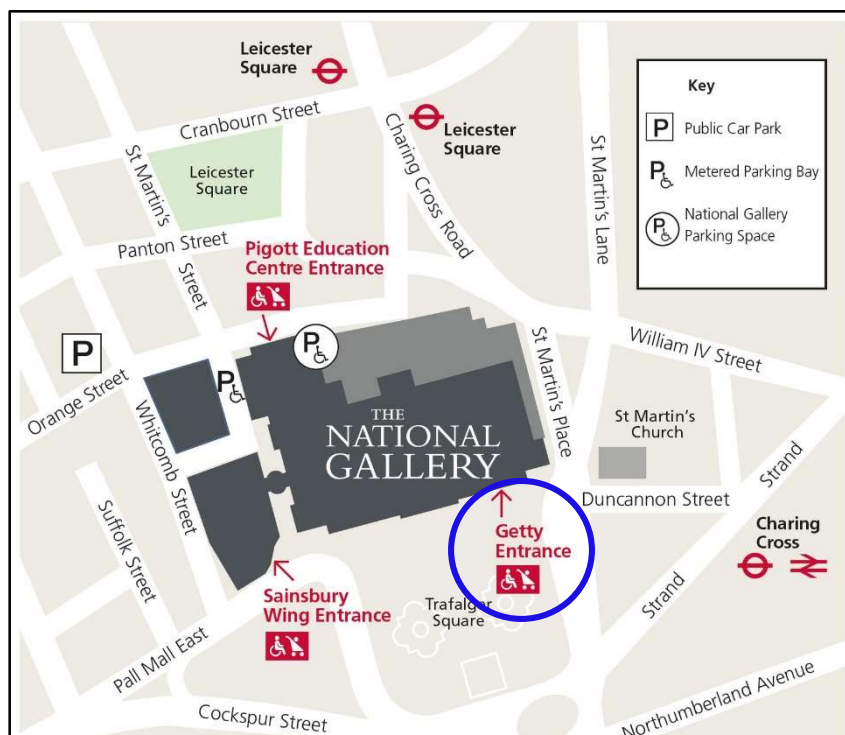
